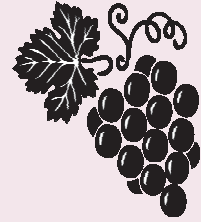

Kerbuccio**
France

Mostly Grenache grapes from practicing organic vineyards in the Languedoc-Roussillon. Black and blue fruits lead into new saddle leather, herbs and tobacco with a seamless finish. Full-bodied and tasty with grilled meats.

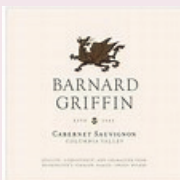

Organic grapes are harvested at night to preserve the fresh fruit flavors. Lime, papaya, herbs and minerals all mingle effortlessly on the palate. Shrimp of any style would be a nice match for this wine.

Washington

From Columbia Valley. An approachable wine offering a juicy core of plum, cherry and orange zest flavors. The silky finish is balanced out by anise and herbs. Pair with roast beef or burgers.

Italy

This Pet-Nat (naturally sparkling) is a blend of Trebbiano and Malvasia. A nose of freshly-baked bread is followed by flavors of citrus and a bit of chalk to give this wine plenty of character. Perfect for salty snacks.

Eguren Egarto Rioja Blanco Spain

Fairly crisp and refreshing, with notes of citrus, white fruits and zippy acids on the finish. This would pair well with salads and appetizers, or just a glass by itself.

Montoya Chardonnay California

From the Monterey area in California, this Chardonnay has oodles of apple, mango and guava flavors, followed by oak, vanilla and a buttery finish. Chicken Fettucine Alfredo is a lovely pairing.

Vin de Savoie Mondeuse France

From 25 year-old Mondeuse vines. Strawberry, raspberry and plum are highlighted by notes of white pepper, cinnamon, clove and smoke. Pork from the grill would be a welcome addition.

Ch. Guiraud G France

A 50/50 blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon. Round and juicy, with notes of citrus and beeswax that are supported by mineral and saline notes. Shrimp scampi would be a nice match.

Castello Colle Massari Rigoletto Italy

Wine has been made in the Montecucco area since the 8th century. Dark berries, walnuts, leather and dried flowers follow through to a medium-bodied wine with firm tannins on the finish. Enjoy with Italian sausage and peppers.

Alvear 3 Miradas Spain

100% Pedro Ximenez grapes. An earthy nose leads into lemon zest, mandarin and mango flavors, with a mouthwatering finish, where nutty and spicy notes linger. Think of this as a light Fino Sherry. Wonderful with olives and Marcona almonds.
