This Ramato-style wine is made from Pinot Gris that has skin contact, which gives the pink hue. Flavors of pear and apricot are front and center, followed by hints of white pepper. Appetizers or Tex-Mex will pair perfectly.

Zacharias Assyrtiko Greece

From the Peloponnese in southern Greece. Juicy melon, peach and citrus flavors. Crisp and lively, this finishes dry and minerally. Pair with shrimp off the grill or seafood salads for a taste treat.

Sobon Rocky Top Zinfandel California
