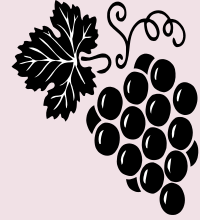

Bernard Fouquet Vouvray Brut France

Organically-grown Chenin Blanc from the Loire Valley. A nose of fresh apples, hay and brioche precedes flavors of lemon zest and ginger. The creamy mousse is fine and lasting. Try it with baked brie topped with fruit compote for a taste treat.

La Bioca Rossese Bianco Italy

Made in Piedmont from a blend of indigenous grapes. Fresh and lively, with notes of apples and pears. Aged in stainless steel on the lees for 5 months to add texture. Pair with seafood, salads or light pasta dishes.

Vernus Sauvignon Blanc Chile

Sperino Rosa Italy

The perfect fall rosé! Lovely notes of ripe peaches, dried orange peel and roses with a silky mouthfeel. The color is a beautiful copper hue. A touch fuller-bodied than Provencal rosés but equally elegant. Pair with grilled salmon or roasted squash.

Gundlach Bundschu Mountain Cuvée California

A Bordeaux-style blend that is meant to be approachable without being simple. Currant and blackberry flavors with a touch of baking spices. Great for burgers, pizza or just when you want a glass of red wine!

Atance Bobal Spain

Organically-grown Bobal grapes see no oak to allow the bright fruit to shine. Bing cherries and red berries with a medium body. Tasty with roast chicken or serrano ham.
