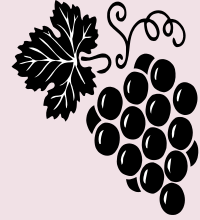

Chéreau Carré Orgueil France

Estate-grown Melon de Bourgogne (the typical grape of Muscadet) is used in this traditional method sparkler. Asian pear, white flowers and a touch of minerality. Perfect as an aperitif, with appetizers or as an accompaniment to oysters.

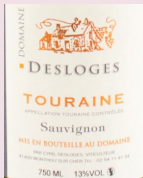

Aromatic notes of rose petal, ginger, and honeysuckle lead to flavors of apricot, lychee and juicy melon. The palate is lush and finishes dry. Lovely with sushi, or try it with pan-seared whitefish on top of a fruit salsa.

Fabre en Provence Rosé France

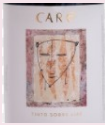

Care Tinto Sobre Lias Spain

A blend of Grenache and Syrah from the Aragon region, aged for 2 months in French oak barrels. Black cherries and blackberries with a touch of baking spice. Smooth and rich on the finish. Tasty with Tex-Mex.
