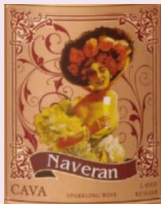

### Naveran Brut Rosé Spain

*Organically-grown Pinot Noir and Parellada grapes are used in this vintage-dated bubbly that is then aged for 12 months on the lees. Strawberries, biscuit dough and wet stones with a lasting mousse. Great with soft cheeses, smoked salmon or chicken dishes.*

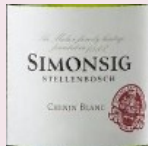

### Olivier Gessler Cotes de Gascogne France

*This family-owned property farms organically and is awaiting certification. Bright and zippy, with notes of grapefruit, lemon and tropical fruit. Pair with fresh cheeses, fish or vegetable salads.*

### Simonsig Chenin Blanc South Africa

*One of the historical wine estates in Stellenbosch, Simonsig makes a great value-driven Chenin. Lime zest, melon, pear and passionfruit with a racy mineral streak. Enjoy it with oysters or sushi.*

### Terroirs du Vent Viognier France

*A small portion of this wine is aged in oak barrels to emphasize the rich mouthfeel that Viognier can have. Wild flower, peach and honeysuckle flavors linger on the finish. Lovely with crab or creamy pastas.*

## Campo Maccione Vermentino Italy

*Aromas of citrus and white peach lead into flavors of yellow plum, grapefruit and almond. The finish is crisp and minerally. Enjoy with seafood in a lemon sauce or salad with vinaigrette.*

## Micheletti Bolgheri Rosso Italy

## Cibonne Tentations Rosé France

## La Linda Cabernet Sauvignon Argentina

## Pike Road Pinot Noir Oregon

## Tenuta di Sticciano Chianti Riserva Italy

*This estate was formed in the mid-1500s under the control of a prominent Tuscan family. The Quercione vineyard (300 meters elevation) produces a rich Chianti with notes of black cherries and damp earth. Pair this complex wine with pasta or beef.*
